PURSUANT TO THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE IATF SCREENING AND VALIDATION COMMITTEE APPROVED BY THE INTER-AGENCY TASK FORCE THROUGH 15 JUNE 2020 IATF RESOLUTION NO. 46-A ANNOUNCED DURING THE TALK TO THE PEOPLE OF PRESIDENT RODRIGO ROA DUTERTE ON CORONAVIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19) LAST 15 JUNE, 2020 AND 11 JUNE 2020 DILG ADVISORY, THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF TAYTAY WOULD LIKE TO INFORM THE PUBLIC OF THE **"EXTENSION OF MODIFIED GENERAL COMMUNITY QUARANTINE AND ITS CORRESPONDING GUIDELINES FROM JUNE 16 TO JUNE 30, 2020, REITERATION ON THE CONTINUOUS BANNING OF COCKFIGHTING IN ALL AREAS UNDER COMMUNITY QUARANTINE IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TAYTAY, PALAWAN AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES"**, WHICH EXPLICITLY PROVIDES THE FOLLOWING DIRECTIVES, TO WIT:

SECTION 1. Quarantine Classification

Beginning June 16, 2020 until June 30, 2020 the Province of Palawan including Puerto Princesa City shall be placed under Modified General Community Quarantine (MGCQ).

SECTION 2. Extension of the Guidelines Enumerated in Public Advisory-006 and the Amendments thereof in Public Advisory-007

All provisions thereof shall remain enforceable until superseded by directives and issuances from the Municipal Inter Agency Task Force Against COVID-19, Inter Agency Task Force (IATF-National), National Government Agencies and the Provincial Government;

SECTION 3. Movement of People: Exemption to Section 5.3 of the 03 June 2020 Guidelines for Areas Placed Under Modified General Community Quarantine

Pursuant to Section 5.4 of 03 June 2020 Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of Community Quarantine in the Philippines, **all persons** are allowed to engage in indoor and outdoor non-contact sports and other forms of exercise such as but not limited to walking, jogging, running, biking, swimming, tennis and badminton for a reasonable amount of time and within the limits of curfew hours. Provided, that the minimum public health standards such as the wearing of masks and the maintenance of social distancing protocols and no sharing of equipment were applicable, are observed;

SECTION 4. Compliance to Local Health Protocols and Procedures

- a. Pursuant to 21 May 2020 DILG MC No. 2020-087 Section IV. d, **all Locally Stranded Individuals (LSIs)** are subject to local health protocols and procedures such as 14-day quarantine and rapid anti-body testing for COVID-19 disease that are consistent with IATF policies. For this purpose, Section III. c of the same memorandum further classified LSIs into: **workers, students, tourist and other individuals in various localities while in transit**;
- b. To effectively prevent any community transmission, **Returning Overseas Filipinos (ROFs)** will be transported by receiving LGUs to the identified Quarantine Facilities in the Barangays or in the Municipality and are also subject to 14-day observation period;

c. **Authorized Persons Outside Residence (APORs).** Movement of Filipino local workers crossing zones for work permitted in the zone of destination shall be allowed. They are subject to the same 14-day observation period in the identified Quarantine Facilities. Otherwise, relevant to the urgency of task, they will be allowed to immediately report for work to be determined by the Municipal Inter-Agency task Force (MIATF). 21 May 2020 DILG MC No. 2020-087 Section III. d, defined Filipino local workers as any member of the labor force, regardless of employment status including working owners and officers, including the following:

- All workers of establishments or principals regardless of employment status;
- All workers of contractors or subcontractors regardless of employment status;
- Visiting workers, consultants or volunteers; and
- On-the-job trainees or other similar hands on learning arrangements, whether paid or unpaid.

SECTION 5. Cockfighting Ban

Pursuant to 11 June 2020 DILG Advisory, in all areas under Community Quarantine, cockfighting or “*sabong*” is banned until such time as the same is allowed through an issuance of the President, the IATF, DILG, or any National Government Agency having jurisdiction on the matter.

SECTION 6. Sanctions

Any violation of the provisions stated herein shall be dealt with in accordance with the existing laws, rules and regulations.

SECTION 7. Effectivity. This shall take effect immediately until 30th of June 2020.

NOTE:

Herein advisory is released with due consideration with the prevailing conditions at the time of its release and is without prejudice to any guidelines that may be subsequently issued by the Inter- Agency Task Force (IATF National), National Government Agencies and the Provincial Government.

Should there be any conflict with the National Guidelines and the provisions of this Advisory, the former shall prevail.

All residents are strongly advised to strictly follow the abovementioned measures.
