THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF TAYTAY THROUGH THE MUNICIPAL INTER-AGENCY TASK FORCE AGAINST COVID-19(MIATF) WOULD LIKE TO INFORM THE PUBLIC OF THE **"MODIFICATION OF CURFEW HOURS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TAYTAY, PALAWAN WHICH SHALL NOW BE FROM 10:00 P.M. TO 5:00 A.M. UNTIL FURTHER MODIFIED AND OTHER GUIDELINES UNDER MODIFIED GENERAL COMMUNITY QUARANTINE"**, WHICH EXPLICITLY PROVIDES THE FOLLOWING DIRECTIVES, TO WIT:

SECTION 1. Reiteration of General Guidelines (Pursuant to Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of Community Quarantine in the Philippines with Amendments as of July 16, 2020)

- a. Minimum public health standards shall be complied with at all times;
- b. The movement of all persons in areas placed under MGCQ shall be limited to accessing essential goods and services, for work in offices or industries permitted to operate and for other permitted activities; and
- c. Any persons below twenty-one (21) years old, those who are sixty (60) years old and above, those with immunodeficiency, comorbidity or other health risks and pregnant women shall be required to remain in their residences at all times, *provided*, that all activities and movements allowed under other sections of the Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of Community Quarantine in the Philippines for the foregoing persons shall continue to be permitted under MGCQ.

SECTION 2. Modified Curfew Hours

All individuals shall observe **curfew hours from 10:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.** subject to exceptions provided in 16 July 2020 *Omnibus Guidelines for the Implementation of Community Quarantine in the Philippines*.

SECTION 3. Adjustment of Business Operations

All business establishments in the municipality shall **operate until 9:00 p.m.** in order to give their employees or staff ample time to prepare and travel home. Take-outs and delivery services must be completed **before 9:00 p.m.**

SECTION 4. Indoor and Outdoor Non-Contact Sports

Pursuant to 16 July IATF Resolution No. 56, s. 2020 amendment of Section 5: *Modified General Community Quarantine*, **spectators in all non-contact sports and exercises shall be prohibited.**

SECTION 5. Prohibitions

Pursuant to 16 July IATF Resolution No. 56, s. 2020 Section D., **the holding of cockfighting and operation of cockpits, beerhouses, nightclubs and similar establishments whose primary business is the serving of alcoholic drinks, shall remain prohibited in areas under Modified General Community Quarantine (MGCQ).**

SECTION 6. Modified Liquor Ban

The selling and purchasing of liquor shall be permitted, but consumption and intoxication of such in public is strictly prohibited.

SECTION 7. Monitoring and Enforcement

This shall be primarily implemented by Taytay Municipal Police Station (TMPS) in coordination with Barangay Officials and barangay force multipliers.

SECTION 8. Penalty

Violators shall be punished in accordance with the penalties provided under Section 9E: "Non-cooperation of the person affected by health events of public concern" of Republic Act No. 11332 or the *Mandatory Reporting of Notifiable Diseases and Health Events of Public Health Concern Act* and other applicable rules and regulations.

SECTION 9. Effectivity. This shall take effect immediately.

NOTE:

Herein advisory is released with due consideration with the prevailing conditions at the time of its release and is without prejudice to any guidelines that may be subsequently issued by the Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF National), National Government Agencies and the Provincial Government.

Should there be any conflict with the National Guidelines and the provisions of this Advisory, the former shall prevail.

All residents are strongly advised to strictly follow the abovementioned recommendations.
